2018 M-TRAC Hosted at ACNM

The 2018 national **Multi-Regional Training and Certification (M-TRAC)** workshop, sponsored by FHWA, was hosted August 1-2 at the ACNM facility by our own New Mexico TTCP. M-TRAC is a regional training group consisting of 14 state highway agencies, industry associations and FHWA. Its primary purpose is to promote training and certification for highway construction materials sampling, testing, and construction inspection.

This year's workshop was attended by 35 technical training administrators and instructors from DOTs, universities and colleges. Topics included web-based training modules, adult learning skills and state presentations to detail what each state's program provide. The networking and exchange of ideas is one of the greatest benefits. Four new states joined the group including training representatives from Texas DOT, Nevada DOT, Oklahoma State University and University of Arkansas.

Our own New Mexico Technician Training and Certification Program (TTCP) sets the standard that many other states envy with dedicated training facility, dedicated full-time training staff, and a small group of demonstrated-ability evaluators that all provide continuity of the training presented. Other state programs are amazed with the success of our longstanding cooperative partnership with New Mexico Department of Transportation delivering on uniformity of training and low cost for NMDOT and ACNM member personnel.

Congratulations to our New Mexico TTCP for a great workshop and continued success.
