

Build America/Buy America (BABA) Training

The Buy America Act (BA) and the Build America, Buy America Act (BABA) are the laws that require the use of domestic made articles, materials, and supplies in certain infrastructure projects. These domestic content regulations apply to all recipients of Federal-aid financial assistance and require iron, steel, manufactured products and construction materials to be produced in the United States.

Federal Highway Administration staff, in conjunction with NMDOT, will discuss the requirements and changes to domestic content procurement by BABA that affect our construction projects.
